We have been keeping an eye on all the rules and regulations being put into place for public safety by the NS Health Authority, Provincial Government and BCM Canada. It is because of these restrictions and guidelines that we announce the incredibly sad news that we will not be opening for the 2020 summer camping season. This difficult decision was made after much prayer, thought and consultation. Because of our concern about the safety and well-being of our campers, staff, volunteers and community we feel this is the best decision for everyone. If you have already registered for camp 2020, we have a few options for you...

Option 1: Full refund can be sent by cheque or e-transfer

Option 2: Full or partial donation of funds to the camp and receive a 2020 receipt. Receipts will come from BCM Intl Canada but will be directed to Mount Traber Bible Camp.

Option 3: Full balance can be transferred to 2021 camp registration.

Option 4: Funds can go towards Traber 2U (more details to come in June)

Dear Campers, Parents Friends and Staff of MTBC,

Given these very uncertain times we here at Mount Traber are still going ahead and preparing for camp this summer, however things can change drastically so we will do our best to navigate through these uncertain circumstances and keep you updated on what that means for summer camp for 2020.

If you are wondering should I register for camp?

1. YES, register for camp online and check one of the 2 options at the end, pay by e-transfer or check. Checking one of these options your child is registered for camp but you pay at a later date when things are clearer as to whether we are allowed to run camp or not.
2. You can still send us a paper registration form by mail. You can include your payment information on the form or attach a cheque; we will not process payments until we know for certain if camp is a go.

To anyone applying or has applied to work at Mount Traber this summer. We have extended the staff application deadline to April 15, 2020. At this time we are not holding staff interviews in person. Keep an eye on your email as this will be the main way we will communicate with you after April 15th, 2020. Also, we are still in need of a life guard for this summer.

As for our April camps, FLOW and MOI will not be cancelled but postponed till the following dates, **FLOW – May 15-17 and MOI – May 22-24.**

We pray you are all staying safe and taking all the necessary pre-cautions we are all being told to take. The sooner we all work together to combat this virus the sooner things can get back to normal.

Keep the camp in your prayers as there is no income coming in with the uncertainty of whether camp will happen this summer or not. The camp still has bills coming in but we ultimately know who is in charge and we trust the Lord will see his will be done and we trust whatever that is.
