WHAT TO BRING

To help you have the best week possible we have provided a list to help you prepare. Please label all belongings so that we can make sure you go home with everything you brought.

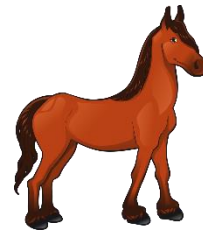
- Sleeping Bag / Bedding
- Fitted Sheet
- Pillow
- Garbage Bag 9 for wet and dirty clothes to go home)
- Clothes for a week of camp and a variety of weather conditions (including extra shoes, extra socks, a jacket, warm sweater, etc)
- Sneakers
- Rain Gear (Jacket, Boots)
- Hat / Cap
- Modest Swimsuit (1-piece, no bikinis, or speedos please- if modesty is in question, camper may be asked to wear a shirt over swimsuit)
- Towels
- Toiletries (soap, toothpaste, toothbrush, shampoo, etc.)
- Insect Repellant
- Sunscreen
- Bible (if you have one)
- Notebook, Pen / Pencil
- Flashlight (be sure that it has batteries that work)
- Water Bottle
- 6 - 10 Masks (Bring 1-2 masks for each day in zip lock baggies labeled for each day)



EXTRA TIPS

- WE ASK THAT ALL CLOTHING BE NON-REVEALING, FREE OF OBSCENE OR OFFENSIVE PRINTING, AND APPROPRIATE FOR THE ACTIVITIES AT CAMP.
- ALSO, THERE ARE A FEW ITEMS THAT WE DON'T WANT YOU TO PACK. PLEASE DO NOT BRING... WEAPONS, VALUABLE ITEMS (LIKE EXPENSIVE JEWELRY), OR ELECTRONICS (IPODS, GAMING DEVICES OR CELL PHONES).
- PLEASE KEEP IN MIND YOUR CHILDREN ARE AT CAMP AND CAMP CAN BE DIRTY. PLEASE DO NOT SEND EXPENSIVE CLOTHING YOU DON'T WANT YOUR CHILDREN TO RUIN.
