Sneakers
Rain Gear (Jacket, Boots)
Hat / Cap
Modest Swimsuit (1-piece, no bikinis, or speedos please- if modesty is in question, camper may be asked to wear a shirt over swimsuit)
Towels
Toiletries (soap, toothpaste, toothbrush, shampoo, etc.) in a case or zip lock bag to carry to the wash house
Insect Repellant
Sunscreen
Bible (if you have one)
Notebook, Pen / Pencil
Flashlight (be sure that it has batteries that work)
Water Bottle
